MARKHAM HEALTH & RESOURCE HUB WINS

WITHIN THE LAST YEAR,
WE'VE SERVICED
APPROXIMATELY 480
FAMILIES.

OF THOSE 480 FAMILIES...

- 700 children from those families received Christmas toys
- **500 children** from those families received book bags
- 395 of those families received boxes of food with nonperishable items and vegetables
- 90 of those families received gas grills
- **32 children** from those families received a bike
- 214 individuals received BP, BMI, and vision screenings, and
- 26 received Glucose checks administered during last year's Winter Fest

MARKHAM HEALTH & RESOURCE HUB WINS

Family Strengthening Preservation

- Currently serving four families in Pompano
- All showed improvement in family functioning

A.D.A.M. (Awesome Dads, Awesome Men) Fatherhood Mentoring Program

- Currently serving 14 fathers in Pompano.
- Three have received help with CDLs
- One with childcare
- Three with housing and
- One with gaining custody of his child.

Beacon of Hope

- Currently serving six Pompano families
- Four have received housing assistance
- Two received assistance with securing childcare or aftercare
- One received a referral for therapy and
- One received a legal assistance referral.

Healing Space

- Serving 33 Pompano families
- 13 received housing assistance
- Six received childcare assistance
- 11 received therapy referrals
- 10 received access and/or referrals to food pantries
- Six received employment assistance and four received utility assistance.
