# About Us

**"Strengthening communities,  
one family at a time."**

Community Based Connections, Inc. (CBCI) is a nonprofit human services organization founded upon 16 years of expertise in delivering youth development, family strengthening, and community empowerment services to hard-to-serve populations in Broward County.

Our mission is to expand opportunities for children to be socially and academically successful, despite the many challenges they face and regardless of the many negative influences around them.

Our programs have a proven impact of decreasing household abuse, keeping families intact, strengthening community connections, and improving student success and engagement at school.

In the last year, Community Based Connections, Inc:

- Served 3,427 people;
- Served 1,652 families;
- Led a health and resource hub in Pompano that provides access to health, housing, education and community resources;
- Provided over 14,828 hours of in-home case management and support services to keep families intact; and
- Conducted 68 fatherhood group session meetings to improve fathers' relationships with their children and help them secure employment.



# Your Generosity Supports our Programs

## Family and Fatherhood

**Awesome Dads Awesome Men (A.D.A.M.)** is a fatherhood mentoring program funded by the Jim Moran Foundation for fathers in Broward County that aims to enhance key life skills and establish healthy behaviors to improve relationships between fathers and their children.

**The Beacon of HOPE-Intact Family Navigation Program**, funded by Broward County, is a coordinated network of services designed to provide in-tact families with emotional support, navigation, and linkage to effective support services where needed and appropriate.

**Family Strengthening Program** is a free three-month, child-centered parenting skills course for families of youth who are at risk of abuse, neglect, and/or juvenile delinquency. Funded through the Children's Services Council of Broward County.

**KIN Connect** ensures caregivers in Broward County (relative or non-relative) have the support they need to meet their children's physical, emotional, and basic needs. This program is funded by ChildNet.

**S.M.A.R.T.** collaborates with the Broward County Sheriff's Department and funded by ChildNet in monitoring safety plans, providing linkage to other community resources, and additional support for investigative efforts.

## Health and Resource Hub

**The Markham Hub** is designed to address the challenges in the Pompano community by providing community-based services and resources that promote equity, accessibility, and sustainability.

## Youth and Education

**Early Achievers at Markham Elementary** provides children access to safe, supervised, fun, and productive year-round out-of-school programming that enhances academic achievement, supports social and physical development, and strengthens children's relationships with peers and adults and within their families, schools, and communities. This program is funded through the Children's Services Council of Broward County.

**Early Achievers** is funded by United Way of Broward County, and provides school-year and summer programming that enhances academic achievement, supports social and physical development and strengthens children's relationships, reducing risk factors

**Young Believers** is funded by Children's Services Council of Broward County, and supports students by providing social emotional support, in achieving short and long term goals, while partnering with the families to provide mortgage, utility, immigration, and rental assistance, while offering case management services and community referrals.

**Club Elevate** is a year-round program, funded by the Children's Services Council of Broward County, that promotes positive youth development by providing struggling high school students with opportunities for academic remediation and enrichment, career exploration, and hands-on learning.

## Mental Health

**Haven** funded by Broward County's Human Services Department Haven is designed to be a safe space that supports the emotional well-being of youth and their families. Through Haven, youth will be able to reclaim and redirect their lives positively.

**Healing Space** is funded by Children's Services Council of Broward County and is a coordinated network of services designed to provide in-tact families with emotional support, navigation, and linkage to effective support services where needed and appropriate.
